I. Commence Workshop

- **A.** White Oaks Recreation and Development Access Joe Eisenhauer of Inch & Co. Presented
 - Impact of setbacks and rights-of-way on possible Lot 90 (maintenance building property) recreation presented.
 - Offered the purchase and dedication of the WellSpan property across from the York Country Day School as a means to capture and satisfy future Regents Glen development recreation requirements along with a fee-in-lieu as necessary.
 - Mr. Eisenhauer indicated he discussed the use of Golf Club Drive for recreation access with the HOA. The HOA said they would not allow such access.
 - Possible Kings Mill Road access mentioned.
 - White Oaks Villas proposed as 131 townhomes right of the country club. Left of the country club would be future multi-family development. Lot 78 is proposed as a 24-unit multi-family building. Thistle Hill would be modeled for townhomes.
 - Commissioners discussed access including emergency access.
- B. 2024 Draft Budget
 - Year-to-date of the current 2023 budget including budget vs actual presented.
 - Changed to the 2024 draft budget per the Budget Committee and updates since budget committee meeting presented.
 - Options to address the Public Works vehicle needs including the transfer of 2023 funds to the Capital Fund for 2024 purchase.
 - Reserve Policy and possible emergency fund presented.
 - 2024 budget discussed along with addressing projected deficit.
 - Budget workshop to be scheduled to continue the budget discussion that includes the Township CFO.
 - Need to consider budgeting for the Road Assessment Plan.
 - Will need to consider addressing the PA American Water treatment rate increase in the sewer budget.
 - Previously planned revenue adjustments discussed.
