Phase II, the macadam trail, was awarded \$75,000 in GTRP grant funds, \$212,000 in grant funds were anticipated and budgeted. The next step is design followed by advertisement for bids.

Developer Recreation Funds have been allocated for the project in the 2026 Budget. The Developer Recreation Fund is funded by developers and must be used for recreation.

ACTION to direct the Engineer to design and update the cost study of Phase II of the Mill Creek Trail and Greenway Project using budgeted Developer Recreation Funds.

2. Fire Station 892 on Indian Rock Dam Road

i) Station Design and Cost
